Know the rules your career might depend on it

→ You need to make sure you know the rules on sports betting. They might change from one season to another. If you don't understand, then ask "your player association" to explain.

→ Being charged with a betting offense can ruin your career and will harm your reputation forever.

Fixing any part of a game is a crime

 \rightarrow It is just as serious to fix the smallest part of a match as it is to fix the world championship.

 \rightarrow If you fix once you will be forever trapped by the match fixers.

You must report any suspicious approaches

 \rightarrow A failure to report approaches is an offense that can lead to long bans.

→ Match fixers will try to trap you slowly through gifts and favours, be careful with your sporting environment and entourage.

You must not gamble on your own sport

 \rightarrow And you must not ask anyone else to bet for you.

 \rightarrow Betting companies and national betting regulators have sophisticated monitoring systems to catch cheats, if you place a bet you will appear on their radar/system.

 \rightarrow Your phone and computer can be taped by the police and may be used as evidence.

Sensitive information should stay within your team

 \rightarrow It is an offense to pass on your knowledge to people who might use it for gambling.
